



PROVISIONAL STATUS REPORTS

- The University of Limerick is the only body which can issue your final results and overall grade.
- The UL Examinations Board meets twice per year in June and in September.
- Approximately six weeks after a student completes their Final Summative Assessments a *Provisional Status Report* will be made available through the NCEF website.
- The student will require their UL Student ID No. to access this report.
- The report will state whether or not they have been successful in attending and completing all their assignments.

The Provisional Status Report will state either:

- a. You have successfully completed all modules
- b. You have been unsuccessful in Module 10 (This will have an action statement under it e.g. To repeat Module 10 Practical Assessment)
- c. You have outstanding requirements (This will have an action statement under it e.g. To complete Module 1 Assessment & Final Summative Assessments)
